

General Shipping Instructions

For our guests from abroad

1. Samples

If correctly declared, samples can be imported duty and VAT free.

a. Shipping of samples

Please fill in our template "Shipping of Samples", which can be found <u>here</u>. <i>This document has to be validated by our import/export department and can be used as an invoice to accompany the shipment.

b. Carry-on of samples

Please fill in our template "Authorization for Carry-on of Samples", which can be found <u>here</u>. This document has to be validated by our import/export department and can be presented at the border upon request.

 Please note that our templates "Shipping of Samples" or "Authorization for Carry-on of Samples" do not have to be completed in case you are shipping or bringing a dry shipper to PSI. Please check our "Dewar / Dry Shipper Delivery Instructions" <u>here</u>.

2. Scientific equipment

The following two options are available for shipment and carry-on of scientific equipment.

a. Carnet ATA

This is the easiest way to arrange a duty and VAT free export and re-import of valuable scientific equipment. A <u>Carnet ATA</u> can be ordered at your local chamber of commerce.

b. Temporary import

In exceptional cases a temporary import can be arranged, should you have difficulties applying for a Carnet ATA. Please fill in our template "Customs Invoice for Instruments", which you can find <u>here</u>. This document has to be sent to our import/export department at least one week prior to shipping.

3. Re-export back to country of origin

- a. PSI will arrange re-export
- b. Transport charges will be charged to receiver
- c. Please send us your delivery instructions in advance
- d. Customs clearance in the country of origin is to be arranged by receiver



4. Shipping company

For a smooth customs clearance we recommend using FedEx or TNT, if possible.

5. Insurance

PSI is not responsible for the insurance of your material during transportation or its usage at our premises.

Please contact our import/export department before sending or bringing scientific equipment, samples or dry shippers to PSI.
