LS² Annual Meeting 2022 – PIs of tomorrow

Geneva, 17 – 18 February 2022

This session offers postdocs interested in an academic career an opportunity to present a plenary talk similar in format to a professorship interview seminar.

Selected participants will have the chance to get a slot for a **15-minute** presentation, which should appeal to a broad audience, and in which the achievements accomplished and the proposed future research is to be explained. The talk will be followed by a 10-minute discussion on various aspects of the proposed activity. A knowledgeable **jury panel of professors** will evaluate the presentations.

The best presentation **will be awarded** a prize. However, everyone is a winner, as all presenters in the session will **receive feedback from the jury in a one-on-one private session** afterward. **Only applicants having ties to Switzerland will be considered** (i.e. Swiss citizenship, Swiss residency, past or ongoing affiliation with a Swiss institution of at least two years by the 2022 meeting). Independent position holders are not eligible.
